

ARTICLE XXV

TEAM ROSTERS

Section 1. Regular Season and Post-Season Rosters: Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by the AFL and the AFLPA, the Active List limit will be twenty (20) players per Team for each regular season and post-season game, and each Team must carry at least eighteen (18) players on its Active List during the regular season and post-season.

Section 2. Inactive List: Inactive List players will receive the same benefits and protections as Active List players.

Section 3. Active and Inactive List Limit: Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by the AFL and the AFLPA, in any League Year, a Team's Active List and Inactive List shall not together, at any time, exceed twenty-four (24) players (collectively the "24-Man Roster").

Section 4. Training Camp Roster Limit: The pre-season cut-down dates will be determined by the AFL, subject to prior consultation with the AFLPA. Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by the AFL and the AFLPA, Teams will be limited to a Pre-Season Training Camp Roster of up to thirty (30) players.

Section 5. Off-Season Roster Limit: Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by the AFL and the AFLPA, a Team may have no more than thirty-seven (37) players on its Off-Season Roster from the beginning of each League Year until the day before the Team's Pre-Season Training Camp begins.

Section 6. Refused to Report List Limit: For League Year 2003: (a) during Pre-Season Training Camp, Teams may have up to eight (8) players on its Refused to Report list; and (b) on the Tuesday before the first regular season game, Teams are required to reduce their Refused to Report list to no more than four (4) players. For League Year 2004 and thereafter, the Refused to Report list shall only apply to players under contract to a Team, and the number of such players on the list shall be unlimited.

Section 7. Emergency Quarterback Roster Spot:

(a) Unless otherwise agreed by the AFL and the AFLPA, for each regular season and post-season game, a Team may designate and dress, from either the Inactive List or the Practice Squad, an Emergency Quarterback in addition to the twenty (20) players on the Active List, who shall be eligible to play only if the two (2) quarterbacks on the Team's roster are unable to play during the game.

(b) If an Emergency Quarterback designated by a Team is a Practice Squad player and plays in a game, he shall receive compensation for such game equal to the minimum Regular Season Per Game Salary (in lieu of Practice Squad Salary for that week). The difference between the minimum Regular Season Per Game Salary and the

Practice Squad Salary will not count against the designating Team's Salary Cap. Notwithstanding the designation of a Practice Squad player as an Emergency Quarterback, his roster status shall remain that of a Practice Squad Player unless he signs an AFL Player Contract with the Team.
